Sena Jazz Laureates At Amersfoort Jazz 2019

SaXPackGirl, an entry from Thailand's Huahin Jazz Festival, raised a joyful noise at Theatre de Lieve Vrouw (roughly translated that's the Sweet Woman Theatre, a designation that fit the visiting reed players perfectly). Delightful front-women Kwang Nisthanun Thaicharoen and Pang Pacharee Sa-guanprasert, on alto and tenor respectively, were as polished as their horns, which seemed to glow. Maybe that was a reflection of absolutely joyful stage personas, which quickly engaged the smiling assembly, through impeccable dual timing and precision delivered with obvious delight. The duo's heartfelt comments on personal history and their upbeat synergy connected with listeners on songs like "Sister" and "Strained in Weakness." The familiar "Pick Up the Pieces" was spiced with alternating solos and some nice twists. When "Dream Town" was dedicated to Amersfoort, the audience's bonding was complete.

The ladies' Youtube channel claims plenty of homeland views, but video doesn't come close to conveying the charm of their live show. Even a cynic anticipating clichés from their somewhat glitzy appearance was quickly converted by the band's effectively earnest efforts. Excellent backup was provided by the Takeshi Band, a solid outfit featuring Puttikorn Wittayarat on guitar, Sompop Praesangeiam on drums, and bassist Wichudes Netsin, joined by frequent French collaborator and very able keyboardist Frank Herrgott.

FEAT. BORIS VAN DER LEK AND PANG

A flamboyant and highly talented pianist, Jochem Braat, was performing later that evening at De Observant,

with the Amsterdam Jazz Trio. Together with a double bass player, Adrie Braat, who is his father, and a drummer, Frits Landesbergen, they are the driving force behind an extravagant tenor saxophonist, Boris van der Lek, who revives the golden age of the stoners with his Hague's courage. Jazz classics are performed, including 'There Is No Business Like Show Business,' 'Broadway,' and 'When I Fall in Love.' Pianist Jochem Braat provides exceptionally imaginative improvisations to complement the explosive contribution of the tenor player. Unexpected appearances are always the charm of the Amersfoort World Jazz Festival. When the Thai alto saxophonist Pang joined the stage, you can feel the tension in the hall rising. 'Take The A Train' has been given a new shine by Pang's provocative performance. Also, her light vibrato that gives a nostalgic touch to her playing is remarkable. Moreover, her contribution, as a second saxophone, in 'On The Sunny Side Of The Street', is impressive. Five musicians closed their set with a swinging 'Boogaloo.'
